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

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## Tribute To Our Founder

Dr. D. P. Pandey was born on February 11, 1910. An academician and educationist of international renown. Dr. Pandey was educated at Banaras Hindu University and the Universities of Cambridge and London. He had been in association with the national freedom struggle in both its revolutionary and Gandhian programmes at the cost of suffering imprisonment twice.

He joined the Vishwa Bharati and came close to Gurudeva Rabindra Nath Tagore. Imbued with idealism, he left for Europe to study and help in the philological restoration, of some abstruse old Javanese Sanskrit text in the Kern Institute, Holland. He unraveled the mystery of the Kavi language as found ensconced in those recondite works. He took his Ph. D degree from Cambridge University. In 1939 he was awarded the Doctor of Letters degree by the Kern Institute, Leiden on his unique work on 'Surya and iconographical study of the Indian Sun God, which came out to be his magnum opus. On his return from Europe with his youthful interest in Archaeology unabated. He had a breakthrough in the field of education, as he was encouraged by Tagore's keen desire to found an institution for educating the youth in the Himalayas on the lines of Vishwa Bharti, so in the year of 1941 as Mussoorie, he established Manava Bharti School for which he received accolades from Mahatma Gandhi, Dr. Rajendra Prasad and Dr. Saravapalli Radhakrishnan. It subsequently has flourished into three purposive centers at Mussoorie, Dehradun and Delhi. His philanthropy and understanding of the unity of man earned for him, the honor of the Order of St. John in 1966 and gave him the chance of being a globetrotter. More than a scholar, Dr. Pandey is a humanist who has espoused the cause of the upliftment of the downtrodden in society, emancipation of women and efflorescence of child education in which directions he made an indelible debt. He left for his heavenly abode on the 26th of September 1989.




## Director's Message

### **TUITION FEE SUPPORT PROGRAMME AVAILABLE**

The aim of the Tuition Fee Reduction Programme (TFRP) is to provide financial assistance to families who would not otherwise be able to benefit from the international education MBIIS offers. The programme supports our strategic goals of broadening both international and social diversity. It is available to students in Grade 1 and above.



## Admission Process

Interested students/parents are required to submit to the Admissions Office a completed MBIS application packet (containing health certificate & other documents), including all requisite forms and documentation listed on the Admission Information Sheet.

Following submission applicants are screened and evaluated for acceptance and for grade level placement with a view toward their successfully gaining promotion from grade to grade, eventually leading to the awarding from CBSE Board for class X & XII.

Based on grade level and language proficiency, testing and screening for placement purposes will take different forms, including but not limited to, consideration of all past school reports in English, a personal interview, school readiness testing, language proficiency testing and a review of previous special needs documentation. The granting or refusal of admission is the responsibility of the Head of School in collaboration with the Principal in charge of that specific grade level.

The admissions process involves these six steps:

1. Submit a completed application form
2. The first step in the admissions process is the submission of a completed application form to MBIS by the parent(s)/guardian(s).
3. Placement testing or Screening

4. Placement testing and/or screening may be arranged depending on submitted documents, grade level and language proficiency.
5. **Application review:** Once all records have been collected, the application will be reviewed by the Principal. Admission may be granted, denied or the School may place the student on a waiting list. In all cases, parent(s)/guardian(s) will be notified by email/ letter.
6. **School Contract:** If admission is granted, parents will be notified in an acceptance letter. The School Contract for the pertinent school year will be enclosed with this letter. This contract must be signed by all respective parent(s)/guardian(s) and returned to the School.

Payment of the initial Entrance and Registration Fees is due once the School Contract has been finalized and before entrance. Invoices will be addressed to the payer as identified in the School Contract and issued shortly thereafter.

### Other Information

- ✓ Fees 50% at the time of admission in March
- ✓ 25% till 25th of July and 25% till 25th of October
- ✓ Mode of Payment - Online (RTGS / Bank Transfer / DD)
- ✓ Before the student begins at MBIIS, parents will receive further information depending on grade level and language proficiency additional meetings may also be arranged.

Applicants may be admitted based on the School's judgement regarding the suitability of the educational programme for the prospective student and space availability. For admission at the beginning of academic year, application documents will be accepted as of January of that particular year, at the earliest. Within 6 weeks of the initial application, all supporting forms and documents should be submitted. A non-refundable Application Fee per child is due and payable at the time of application.

### Application Materials

- ✓ A Transfer Certificate from the school last attended clearly mentioning the class in which the child was studying.
- ✓ A birth certificate issued by a Municipal Authority.
- ✓ A certificate of conduct.
- ✓ A medical certificate, giving details of general health and blood group of the student.



# Student Transportation

Manava Bharati India International School, Mussoorie offers transportation to outings and excursions organised by the school authorities. Frequent educational trips in and around Mussoorie are a part of curriculum.



## General Rules

- No student is allowed to leave the school premises during school hours without written request from the parent/guardian. In case of boarders, the Principal must receive the request atleast ten days prior to commencement of holidays/leave period.
- Parents/guardians are requested not to ask for any leave for their wards for attending functions. The school will not be responsible if a student leaves the school campus without permission.
- All students should attend the school regularly. Extension of vacation leave is granted only under very special circumstances.
- Students leaving without prior notice or whose names are struck off from the rolls for unexplained reasons, will not be, as a rule, re-admitted. If re-admitted, upon their late return, they will have to pay the admission charges again.
- Late arrivals to the school shall be fined. A fine of Rs.500/- per day will be imposed if a student is absent on the opening/re-opening of the school, till he/she comes back and disciplinary action will be taken against them.
- All students have to go on a compulsory educational tour organised by the school during April/October.

## Rules for Visitors

- Parents will not be allowed to visit until and unless prior permission is taken from the Principal or mentioned in the school Calendar.
- The visitors other than parents should have authorized letters and identification cards to be permitted to meet the ward/wards.
- Parents will be allowed to meet their ward only on second Saturday between 10am to 4.30pm.
- Office timing 9.00am to 4.00pm on all working days.
